"Drenched with Life" August 4, 2012

<u>PROP</u>- (John 10:10) It is Jesus' deepest desire to fill us with life—"more and better life than (you) ever dreamed of" [The Message]. He does this by "drenching us (baptizing us)" with the Holy Spirit.

1. HE LONGS FOR "A RESTING PLACE"—where He can fully be Himself

SEE ISAIAH 66:1-2- Who does He "esteem" (favor with Himself)? He who "trembles at My word"- to hasten, respond w/o hindrance, indifference or delay (i.e., firefighters, soldiers, early responders)

'I will destroy this manmade temple and in three days will build another, not made by man.' (Mark 14:58) They misunderstood Him—which they often did—but Jesus was referring to a new covenant & a new dwelling place—in us!

SEE EPHESIANS 2:22 (NIV) "A temple in which God is quite at home" (The Message)

2. THAT'S WHY JESUS WANTED THEM NOT ONLY TO "RECEIVE" THE HOLY SPIRIT—BUT TO BE "BAPTIZED WITH" THE HOLY SPIRIT

John 20:22- Jesus' first order of business as He met with His disciples post-resurrection: "He breathed on them, and said: 'Receive the Holy Spirit."

- At that moment, the Holy Spirit took up residence "in" them
- Like a "pilot light"—His life sparked within them
- Every born-again believer has the Holy Spirit "in" them
 - o "Born of the Spirit" (John 3:6)
 - He "testifies with our spirit that we are children of God" (Romans 8:16)
- BUT Jesus said: "There's more" [SEE LUKE 24:49]
 - "Father's promise" to "clothe you with power"
 - "Clothe"- to sink down into; be engulfed by; arrayed with layers of roval garments
 - John the Baptist: "He (Jesus) will baptize you with the Holy Spirit" (Mark 1:8)
 - A cloth dyed—every fiber transformed
 - A sunken ship—totally under the influence of the sea
- That's why Jesus said: "I will give you REST" (Matthew 11:28)
 - Not inactivity...but interactivity
 - o Be stilled, quieted
 - o Be completely enveloped—permeated with

3. HE DESIRES TO BE "UPON" US

Acts 8:14-17- Believers in Samaria

"In"- the pilot light was on

"Upon"- they became engulfed in the Holy Spirit's "flame"

NOTE: Jesus is looking for a relationship where He can "completely envelope and permeate us." A "temple" He can abide "IN" (intimacy with us; discover Him) and "UPON" (reflect Him, Lit.- "re-present" Him to the world around us).

RESPONSE

The Holy Spirit is being "poured out UPON all flesh".

In the Book of Acts, people in various "heart postures" received His outpouring:

- 1. Eager to be filled (Acts 2)
- 2. Receptive (Acts 8:14-23) Believers in Samaria
- 3. Resistant (Acts 9:1-18) Saul of Tarsus
- 4. <u>Uninformed</u> (Acts 19:1-6) Ephesus: "We have not even heard there is a Holy Spirit" (v. 2)
- 5. <u>Unlikely</u> (Acts 10:44-47) The Gentile household of Cornelius [NOTE: Mostly all early believers were religious Jews]

Whatever the category you may find yourself in—the Holy Spirit is still being poured out **(Lit.- "without reserve")** upon every life.
